A system that stops at the roof edge leaves frozen gutters with nowhere to drain. A complete installation runs cable through the gutter trough and down the downspout to the ground, keeping the full drainage path open and protecting fascia boards from the hidden damage of sustained ice loads.



## 4. Does the Work Come With a Warranty?

A workmanship warranty, separate from the manufacturer's product warranty, signals the company stands behind its installation. Ask what it covers and how long it runs. A clear, direct answer confirms the installer will address issues after the job is complete.

## 5. How Well Do They Explain the System?

How clearly an installer explains the cable layout, the role of each component, and how the self-regulating thermostat works is evidence of genuine expertise. Vague answers about your specific roof's layout are a warning sign; a qualified installer should be able to walk you through every decision in plain terms.



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
